Although Cllr Eley and Mr Doran made representations at the meeting, maintaining their objections to the proposal, Cllr Eley considered that these submissions had been overlooked by the Committee in reaching their decision.</p>
2.	<p><b>Planning Application No. 15/07057/FUL – Long Barn, Lower Stanton St Quintin, SN14 6DB Conversion part of dwelling to mixed use comprising tourist accommodation and training facilities with associated works.</b></p> <p>SSQ PC resolved to support this application subject to the following conditions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Clarification re number of parking spaces and measures to mitigate light and noise pollution, particularly given intended hours of working to 9 pm.</li> <li>• New access road and parking area to remain ancillary to the main dwelling (Long Barn).</li> </ul>
3.	<p><b>Planning Application No. 15/08031/FUL – 29A Seagry Road, Lower Stanton St Quintin SN14 6DB Conversion of bungalow to a hosue by adding a second storey and new roof.</b></p> <p>SSQ PC understands that immediate neighbours have no concerns in relation to this application and resolved to support the proposal.</p>
4.	<p><b>Planning Application No. 15/07908FUL – No. 1 Court Gardens, Stanton St Quintin, SN14 6DF Erection of Garage</b></p> <p>SSQ PC understands that immediate neighbours have no concerns in relation to this application and resolved to support the proposal.</p>
5.	<p><b>Input for Area Board Meeting on 07/09 – Highways</b></p> <p>SSQ PC resolved to provide feedback to the Area Board meeting via the Parish Forum, indicating that Wiltshire Council's provision of highway maintenance services is poor in a number of respects including procedures for communication of issues and response; and repair/maintenance of the highway.</p>
