6. **Application to Register Land at Seagry Road, Stanton St Quintin as a Village Green:**

Letter received from Wiltshire Council. The application has been allotted application number 2018/01. The application has been registered only in part, excluding an area of land which was, at the time of application, subject to a planning trigger event (planning application 18/01108/FUL) which extinguishes the right to apply to register land as a village green, over that part of the land. It is now possible to apply to register the excluded area of land as a Village Green as a separate application and after discussion it was **recommended** that this further application is made to Wiltshire Council.
