

**MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE STANTON ST QUINTIN PARISH
COUNCIL HELD ON 3rd JULY 2019**

2. **Apologies:** Nil

3. **Public Question Time;** Questions were asked re the Planning Application 18.08271/OUT – amended plans. It was asked why the amended plans were being considered when the application relating to the runway use etc had been called in. It was stated that these amended plans relate to the original substantive application made in September 2018 and these were amended plans regarding the layout of the roundabouts.

Cllr Greenman explained that there had been a separate application number 19/02543/FUL which had been discussed on 23rd April 2019 and this application had been called into Committee.

He said that he would also call this application in.

Several concerns were raised and it was stated that the Parish Council should take notice of the views of the parishioners.

Mr Murton stated that the Parish Council had been democratically elected to represent the views of the Parish and he did not like some of the accusations that were being made. Because of this he stated that he would be resigning from the Parish Council at the end of the meeting.

The issue of the pedestrian crossing would be considered at the next Parish Council meeting.

4. **Planning applications:** The following applications were considered:

18/08271/OUT Hullavington Airfield, A429 rd NE from Airfield to Kingway Bridge – Revised plans

Outline planning for up to 44,150 sq m of development comprising test areas, an energy centre, a logistics/storage building, hangar building, staff and customer facilities and gatehouse, retention and extension of operational runway and new access arrangements, comprising a realigned section of C1 road and new

roundabouts at both the junction of the A429/C1 roads and on the C1 road

There were no objections to the amended plans re the positioning of the roundabout.

However the concerns raised re application 19/02453/FUL still stood ie

“No objections in principle to the construction of a new hangar or the extension to the existing runway and airfield fencing.

However, concerns had been expressed about the runway lighting which could cause light pollution to nearby properties.

There were also issues which need to be addressed regarding the use of the airfield and if the application is approved, there should be a restriction placed on the number of flights permitted and the times as there should be no night flying.

The Parish Council felt that there needed to be more clarification on this and that a noise evaluation should be carried out”.

19/05973/TCA MoD, Church road, Stanton St Quintin
Fell 6 Lime trees

No objections but would request that replacement trees are planted

5. To consider an alternative contractor for grass cutting in the Village:

It was reported that Envisage Grounds Maintenance did not feel able to continue with the contract to cut the areas of grass in the village. They were no longer cutting the school grounds and did not feel that it was viable to continue with the other areas.

It was **recommended** that Ben Clarke be appointed to cut the grass in the village at a cost of £57.50 per month.
