

**Minutes of meeting of the Stanton St Quintin Parish Council (SSQ PCC).
held on 10 December 2019
SSQ Church Hall**

3 - The purpose of the meeting was to reconsider planning application:

19/10844/FUL – Stanton St Quintin Service Station, demolition of existing service station and rebuilding new replacement Service Station.

Questions were raised as follows:

- The lack of parking on the planning application for lorries, as they are currently parking overnight on double yellow lines on the public road at the rear of the service station.

Access to the rear of the Service Station and little information on traffic flow reports.

- Additional light pollution to properties in the vicinity of the proposed new Service Station

AA advised members of the public to raise their concerns with Wiltshire Planning.

The planning itself was supported by all the Parish Councillors present, as the current planning application has resolved many of the issues originally raised when the previous application was rejected by the PCC. However, the approval is subject to the following provisions:

- Regarding the lack of HGV parking, the PCC felt that there could be space on the site for HGV parking.
- Flow of traffic and light pollution.
- The developers to provide CCTC cameras at the rear of the property to deter lorry drivers parking on double yellow lines and/or littering the area around their HGV's.

4 – Public Questions received

The status of the Village Green was raised, AA advised that he has had a lot of too'ing and fro'ing with the paperwork that he has had to alter and return on several occasions to Wiltshire County Council. These alterations are to ensure everything is completed correctly and the status of the application has progressed to Category 3 status.
